At Southern Hancock Schools our vision is "Achieving our Personal Best in Pursuit of Excellence". In order for students to start the year off prepared and ready for excellence, we ask that students have the required materials for all of the following classes on their schedule.

MATHEMATICS

All students taking a Math class should have the following items:

- 1" 3-Ring Binder (used for Math only)
- Loose Leaf Paper
- Pencils
- Calculator (see below)**
- Dividers (optional)
- Graph Paper (optional)

**Specific Calculators are needed for specific math classes. Recommended Scientific Calculators – TI-30XIIS or TI-30XS Recommended Graphing Calculators – TI-84 or TI-84 Plus (Graphing Calculators may be available to rent in the book store while supplies last)

- Algebra 1 – Scientific Calculator
- Algebra 2 – Scientific or Graphing Calculator
- Honors Algebra 2 – Graphing Calculator
- Geometry – Scientific Calculator
- Honors Geometry – Scientific Calculator
- Integrated Math I, II, & III – Scientific Calculator
- Trig / Pre-Calculus – Graphing Calculator
- AP Calculus – Graphing Calculator
- AP Statistics – Graphing Calculator
- College Math – Graphing Calculator
- Analytical Algebra 1 – Scientific Calculator
- Finite Math-Scientific or Graphing calculator

SCIENCE

All students taking a Science class should have the following items:

- Loose Leaf Paper (College Ruled)
- 3-Ring Binder (1" or larger)*
- MacBook Compatible Earbuds
- Pens / Pencils

Some Science classes require additional materials...

- Chemistry – Scientific Calculator
- Advanced Chemistry – Scientific Calculator
- AP Chemistry – Graphing Calculator Suggested (if unable to get Graphing, a Scientific Calculator)
- Biology – Colored Pencils
- Earth & Space Science – Colored Pencils
- Physics – Scientific Calculator
- Anatomy/Physiology* – 2" 3-Ring Binder and 24 Pack of Colored Pencils
- Integrated Chemistry/Physics – Colored Pencils
- Environmental Science – Colored pencils
- AP Environmental Science – Scientific Calculator
- Human Body Systems – Colored Pencils and Scientific Calculator

Recommended Scientific Calculators – TI-30XIIS or TI-30XS Recommended Graphing Calculators – TI-84 or TI-84 Plus (Graphing Calculators may be available to rent in the book store while supplies last)

ENGLISH

All students taking an English class should have the following items:

1 Subject Notebook or Composition Notebook

Folder or Binder (used for English only) Pens / Pencils

Some English classes require additional materials...

- Regular English 9 – Highlighters & Colored Pencils
- Regular English 10 – MacBook Compatible Earbuds
- Early College English 10 – MacBook Compatible Earbuds
- Honors English 10 – Highlighters & Colored Pencils
- Regular English 12 – Glue & Colored Pencils (both optional)

SOCIAL STUDIES

All students taking a Social Studies class should have the following items:

Folder

Notebook

Pencils

Blue or Black Pens

Colored Pencils

Highlighters

Students taking Dual Credit US History, Early College US History, or AP Psychology need the following:

- 1" 3-ring binder
- Dividers for the binder
- Dual credit ECON students should also have a calculator.

BUSINESS & TECHNOLOGY

Some Business & Technology classes require specific materials...

- Graphic Design – MacBook Compatible Earbuds or Headphones, USB Drive (helpful, but not mandatory)
- Intro to Accounting – Calculator (any kind)
- Early College Career Planning – Colored pencils/ markers, earbuds/headphones
- Early College Intro to Comp Concepts – Colored pencils/markers, earbuds/headphones
- Accounting – Colored pencils/markers, calculator
- Business Management – Colored pencils/markers, earbuds/headphones.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

All students taking a Foreign Language class should have the following items:

A Folder or 3-Ring Binder (to be used only for Foreign Language)

MacBook Compatible Earbuds

Pens/Pencils

Loose Leaf Paper

*Dual Credit Spanish and Dual Credit French may have additional requirements including a text required by the university

All students taking a FACS class* should have the following items:

Notebook

Folder

MacBook Compatible Earbuds

Colored Pencils and/or Markers

2 Glue Sticks
